SESSION 3: REPORTING TOOLS

Learn how to use system reports to gather invaluable information about your school population. From determining which students have made honor roll to examining class and teacher loads using scheduling reports, PowerSchool SIS system reports provide the information you need. The session ends with an exploration of reports available in PowerSchool's Enterprise Reporting tool.



SESSION 1: FINDING INFORMATION

Review reports that identify which students are at risk and which students are excelling. The session ends with an exploration of reports available in PowerSchool's Enterprise Reporting tool.
