What's fixed in PowerSchool SMS 8.0.0.010006

This section describes the issues in PowerSchool SMS 8.0 that Pearson has fixed with PowerSchool SMS 8.0.0.010006. (The SMSMAINT numbers are tracking numbers for changes to PowerSchool SMS features and capabilities.)

Contacts

Unable to see OK and Cancel buttons in Link Sibling/Link Other Person dialogs

(SMSMAINT-20761)

On the Contact List page, when you clicked the Link Sibling & Sibling Contacts or Link Other Person button, the OK and Cancel buttons were not visible on the resulting dialogs.

Preconditions: Resolution set to 1024x768.

Fix verification steps:

- 1 Find and open a student record.
- 2 In the control bar, click Contacts. The Contact List page appears.
- 3 Click Link Sibling & Sibling Contacts. The dialog appears with the OK and Cancel buttons visible.
- 4 Click Cancel and repeat steps 2 and 3 for the Link Other Person dialog. The dialog appears with the OK and Cancel buttons visible.

cTools

Unable to save data in cTools field

(SMSMAINT-20830)

For a field in the Contacts or Enrollment feature area cTools, if the name in the **Database field name** and **Schema field name** fields differed, when you attempted to save data into that field in the interface, the following error occurred: *Invalid column name 'tablename'*.

Preconditions:

- 1 A custom Extension is created for a schema in the Contact feature area. The Extension has at least one panel with one field created where the Database field Name and Schema field name are different. There is a student with at least one contact record.
- 2 A custom Extension is created for a schema in the Enrollment feature area. The Extension has at least one panel with one field created where the Database field Name and Schema field name are different. There is a student with at least one enrollment record.

Fix verification steps:

- 1 Contact feature
 - a Find and open a student record for the student from the preconditions.
 - **b** In the control bar, click Contacts. The Contact List page appears.
 - c Click a contact's name. The Edit Contact page appears.
 - d Enter data into the cTools field from the preconditions and click OK. No error occurs.
- 2 Enrollment feature
 - a Find and open a student record for a student from the preconditions.
 - **b** In the control bar, click Enrollments. The Enrollments page appears.
 - c Hover the cursor over an enrollment and click the pencil (edit) icon in the Comment column. The Edit School Enrollment page appears.
 - d Enter data into the cTools field from the preconditions and click OK. No error occurs.

Enrollment

Immigration field should be a Yes/No field

(SMSMAINT-20751)

If the Immigrant Student field was designated as a required field, when you enrolled a new student, the Immigrant Student field on the Enrollment page allowed any three characters to be entered. **Preconditions**: The Immigrant Student field is selected as a required field on the District Setup > Registration/Enrollment Preferences page.

Fix verification steps:

- 1 In the Search menu, click Registration/Enrollment. The Registration/Enrollment Search page appears.
- 2 Click New. The Register Student page appears.
- 3 Complete the required fields and click Enter Address & Contact Data.
- 4 Complete the required fields and click Enroll. The Enroll Student page appears.
- 5 View the Fields Required/Recommended for Enrollment panel. The Immigrant Student field is a drop down Yes/No field.

Error when entering phone number for newly enrolled student

(SMSMAINT-20794)

When you attempted to add or edit a phone number for a newly enrolled student, the following error occurred: *Unique key constraint is violated...*

Fix verification steps:

- 1 Sign in as a School Administrator.
- 2 In the Search menu, click Registration/Enrollment. The Registration/Enrollment Search page appears.
- 3 Click New. The Register Student page appears.
- 4 Complete the required fields and click Enter Address & Contact Data.
- 5 Complete the required fields and click Enroll. The Enroll Student page appears.
- 6 Complete the fields and click OK.
- **7** Find and open the student's demographic record.
- 8 Click the Address/Phone tab and enter a phone number
- 9 Click OK. No error occurs and the changes are saved.

Error when attempting to open Contact Information page

(SMSMAINT-20816)

When you attempted to open the Contact Information page from the Registration page, the following error occurred: [SchoolStudent] object with key value [xxxxxx].

Fix verification steps:

- 1 Find and open a student record.
- 2 In the control bar, click Registration. The Register Student page appears.
- 3 Click Enter Address & Contact Data. No error occurs and the Contact Information page appears.

PowerTeacher gradebook quick link

Unable to use PowerTeacher Gradebook quick link

(SMSMAINT-20631)

When you attempted to use the PowerTeacher Gradebook quick link, the following error occurred: *404 - file or directory not found*

Preconditions: School is set up to use PowerTeacher and PowerTeacher URL is correct on General Preferences page.

Fix verification steps:

- 1 Sign in as a school administrator.
- 2 In the Actions menu, select Customize Home Page. The Customize Home Page page appears.
- 3 Under Quick Links, in the Available Quick Links list, select PowerTeacher Gradebook and click Add.
- 4 Click OK. The Home > Quick Search page appears.
- 5 In the Quick Links menu, click PowerTeacher Gradebook. No error occurs.

Reports

Failing Grades Report (Secondary) missing some students

(SMSMAINT-20795)

When you ran the Failing Grades Report (Secondary), some students with failing grades did not appear in the report. Note: This was a coding issue only; you are **not** required to upload a new report package. Note: This fix corrects the same issue for the Missing Grades report.

Fix verification steps:

- 1 Sign in as a School Administrator.
- 1 In the Admin menu, click Reports. The School Reports page appears.
- 2 Under Grading Reports, click Failing Grades Report (Secondary).
- 3 Click Run. The report runs and displays all students with failing grades.

Student Demographics

Students grade level not updating after grade level change

(SMSMAINT-20735)

When you changed a student's grade level on the Demographics page, the grade level did not update and the student did not appear in any student lists for the new grade level.

Fix verification steps:

- 1 Sign in as a School Administrator.
- 1 Find and open a student record (e.g., grade 10 student).
- 2 Change the grade level in the Current Grade Level field to a different grade (e.g., grade 11).
- 3 Click OK.
- 4 Click the PowerSchool SMS logo to return to the Home > Quick Search page.
- 5 Click the link for grade 11 students. The student's name appears in the list.
- 6 Click the student's name. The Demographics page opens and the student's grade level has been updated.

Unable to change homeroom after grade level change

(SMSMAINT-20736)

After you changed an elementary student's grade level, and then attempted to select a homeroom for the new grade level, the following error occurred: *The student's grade is not taught in the homeroom you have selected. Select a different homeroom or a different grade.*

Fix verification steps:

- 1 Sign in as an elementary School Administrator.
- 2 Find and open a student record (e.g., a grade 2 student).
- 3 Change the grade level in the Current Grade Level field to a different grade (e.g., grade 3) and click Apply.
- 4 In the Homeroom drop down, select the applicable homeroom.
- 5 Click Apply. No error occurs and the new homeroom is saved.

Installing PowerSchool SMS 8.0.0.010006 HotFix

To install the PowerSchool SMS HotFix, complete the following steps:

- 1 Apply the Database Server HotFix for 8.0.0.010006 (p. 5).
- 2 Apply the Web Server HotFix for 8.0.0.010006 (p. 6).

Apply the Database Server HotFix for 8.0.0.010006

- 1 On the database server, create a folder that will contain the PowerSchool SMS files.
- 2 In the browser on the database server, go to *Pearson PowerSource* (<u>https://powersource.pearsonschoolsystems.com</u>).
- 3 Enter your user name and password. Click Log in. Click the Support tab. The Support home page appears.
- 4 Click Downloads. The Downloads page appears.
- 5 Under Available Resources, click <u>PowerSchool SMS</u>. The PowerSchool SMS home page appears.
- 6 Under Available Resources, click <u>Releases and Updates</u>, and then click PowerSchool SMS 8.0.0.010006 HotFix. The PowerSchool SMS 8.0.0.010006 HotFix download page appears.
- 7 Under Available Resources, click the download icon () for each file, download the files and save them to the folder you created in step 1.
- 8 In the folder, double-click Chancery_SMS_8.0.0.010006 _DB_Installer.exe.
 ① If a Security Warning appears, click Run.
- 9 In the dialog, "Do you want to upgrade your version of the PowerSchool SMS DB to 8.0.010006?", click Yes.
- 10 When the InstallShield Wizard Complete dialog appears, click Finish.
- 11 Verify that the database installer was applied correctly:
 - a Click Start > Control Panel > Add or Remove Programs. The Add or Remove Programs dialog appears.
 - b Select PowerSchool SMS Database 8.0 Database, and then click <u>Click here for</u> <u>support information</u>. The Support Info dialog appears.
 - c Ensure the Version number is 8.0.0.010006, and then click Close.
- 12 In the Add or Remove programs dialog, click Change. The Database Identification dialog appears.

- 13 Click Database Maintenance. Click Next.
- 14 Select the database you want to update. Click Update Database.
- **15** Enter the SQL Administrator Password, Database Username, and Database Password created when the database was initially added.
 - Important Note: When entering the database username and database password, do not enter the SQL Administrator username and password or the update will fail. Make sure you enter the name and password of the database owner (dbo).
- 16 Click Next in each dialog.
- 17 When the database update confirmation prompt appears, click OK.
- **18** When the Database Identification dialog re-appears, click Exit, and then close the Add or Remove Programs dialog.

Apply the Web Server HotFix for 8.0.0.010006

Note: If you have separate servers for the database and web, save Chancery_SMS_8.0.0.010006 _Web_Installer.exe to the web server.

- 1 Double-click Chancery_SMS_8.0.0.010006 _Web_Installer.exe.
- 2 In the dialog, "Do you want to upgrade your installed version of PowerSchool SMS to 8.0.0.010006?", click Yes.
- 3 Click Finish to complete the update.
- 4 Verify that the web installer was applied correctly:
 - a Click Start > Control Panel > Add or Remove Programs. The Add or Remove Programs dialog appears.
 - b Select PowerSchool SMS Database 8.0 Web, and then click <u>Click here for</u> <u>support information</u>. The Support Info dialog appears.
 - c Ensure the Version number is 8.0.0.010006, and then click Close.
