Activity #1:

- Click on **Report Results** from the icons on the center of the page.
 - Click on **Proficiency by Test**
 - Select the test folder **Learnia New Jersey DOE G05 Reading ClassViews**
 - Select the test **New Jersey DOE G05 Reading ClassViews A**
 - **Scroll down** and click on **Create Report**
 - Click **OK** to the pop-up window on **System Default Scale**
1. What are the four levels of proficiency?
 2. What percentage of students is at the **basic** level of proficiency?
 3. Within the basic group, list the names of the students who are at the highest and lowest levels of proficiency, respectively.
 4. Look at the lowest performing student in the group of basic proficiency, which CPI(s) would you focus on most heavily? Why?

Activity #2

- **Report Setup** button at the bottom of the screen OR **Report Results** on the left navigation bar.
- Click on the **Proficiency by Standard**.
- Select the test folder **Learnia New Jersey DOE G05 Reading ClassViews**
- Select the test **New Jersey DOE 05 Reading ClassViews A**
- Select the standard **Learnia New Jersey DOE Reading CLV**
- **Scroll down** and click on **Create Report**
- Click **OK** to the pop-up window on **System Default Scale**.

6. Click on the CPI with the lowest percentage.

 - b. How many children would you identify as needing remediation?
7. Close this window to take you back to the proficiency by standard graph and find the following CPI: Students will make inferences using textual information.... *(Hint: The class overall met basic proficiency.)*
 - a. What was the percentage of proficiency for the class?
 - b. How many questions assess this CPI?
 - c. How many children would you identify as needing remediation?

Activity #3:

- **Click on Report Setup** at the bottom of the screen OR **Report Results** on the left navigation bar.
 - **Click on the Student Proficiency List.**
 - **Select** the test folder **Learnia New Jersey DOE G05 Reading ClassViews**
 - **Select** the test **New Jersey DOE G05 Reading ClassViews A**
 - **Scroll down** and **click on Create Report**
 - **Click OK** to the pop-up window on **System Default Scale**
