

Station 3: After the Storm

The goal of this station is to apply understanding of the consequences of natural disasters to help determine how they affect communities.

Review student sheet before starting station activities.

Step 1: Examine the Images

As a group, examine the four images at the table.

Step 2: Analyze the Images

- Individually, choose two images to analyze more deeply.
- For each image, complete one organizer on the Student Sheet
 - o Record any emotional effects you see.
 - Record any physical damages you see.
 - Examine your observations and determine which are explicitly stated and which are inferences.
 - Categorize your observations accordingly on the organizer.

Step 3: Discuss the Findings

• Share your observations with the members of your group. Discuss both the emotional effects and physical damages you identified and identify why they stood out to you.

Step 4: Draw Conclusions

 Use your notes and observations to answer the guiding question on the back of the organizer.

Step 5: Data Collection Sheet

- Use your Data Collection Sheet to note how this station helped you answer any of the essential questions:
 - o How do we prepare for disasters?
 - What are some emotional, physical, mental, and financial effects of disasters?
 - What role do human strength and resilience play in recovering from disasters?
