Useful information is organized as follows:

- **District and Local Tests** – see data on benchmark (interim) assessments that are in progress or completed
- **Classroom Tests** – see data on in-progress and completed classroom tests (tests that you created for your students or that were assigned or recommended by an administrator)
- **Standardized Tests** – see results for available standardized tests (including prior- year tests)
- **Upcoming Tests** – see a list of upcoming tests related to your sections, along with test names, online passcodes, and test status (stages)

Use the Upcoming Tests tab to see up to 10 current tests at a glance. Select a test name to view test details and links to other features.

Click the “View all” button to see all tests related to the selected section.

Standardized Tests Tab

Under the **Standardized Tests** tab, select the **Test Name** and **Test Date** or leave the default value, the most recent standardized test data per student.

The numbers in the cells represent the percentage of students in a section who earned a proficient score for the tested subjects. Scores appear by student for the selected subject. Click another subject to change the view. The colored boxes indicate the score groups.

Under **Filter By Score Group**, roll your cursor over a square to view the associated score group or click the square to filter the students.

Click **Standards Mastery** to run a report of the number of students per score group and subject for the selected class.
