Key Performance Indicator Quick Start Guide

A Key Performance Indicator (KPI) is a quantifiable metric for gauging institution performance.

Two Ways to View KPIs

1. My Schoolnet (CIITS Homepage)

Once logged in to CIITS, you will see the **Key Performance Indicator Overview**. You can view different KPIs in different categories using the drop-down menu.
