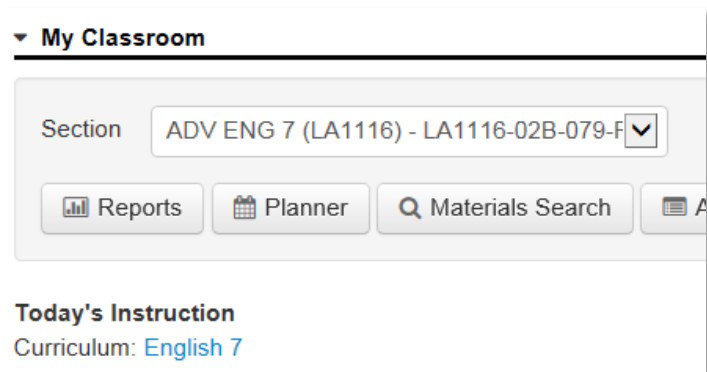


Schoolnet: Mapping Curriculum to a Course

Audience Roles: Leadership, Staff with Materials Approver

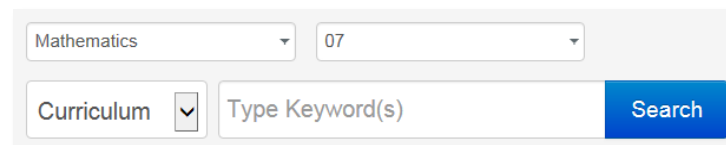
Curriculum loaded into Schoolnet through Curriculum Manager can be linked, or “mapped,” to courses. Doing so allows a teacher to quickly access the curriculum via a link on both the home page and the Student Performance page, rather than searching for it in the Materials Bank. Only district-level users with the Curriculum Manager role can create curriculum and map it to courses.



Mapping Curriculum to a Course

1. Roll your cursor over **Classrooms** and click **Instructional Materials**
2. Select **Curriculum** as the type, then filter the curriculum by subject and grade

3. Click **Search**



4. Click the title of the curriculum you want to map
5. Click the **Course Mappings** tab
6. Click **Create a New Mapping**
7. Filter the list of courses by **Grade Range, Department,** and **Keyword**
8. Click **Search**

The results indicate how many sections currently exist for each course and list any currently linked curriculum.

9. Check the box next to the courses you want to associate with the curriculum

Use the **Select all on this page** link to select all of the courses in the current list.

10. Click **Create Mapping(s)**

You successfully mapped the curriculum to the courses. You will see a message stating the curriculum has been mapped to the courses listed.
